

Letter From Our Pastor, Fr. John Paul Lewis

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It's hard to believe that Lent is already coming to an end, and in just one short week, we will be celebrating Easter Sunday. It seems like we just began with Ash Wednesday, and in the midst of the busyness of this last month, Lent has flown by. Maybe Lent was a blessed time for you; the Lord blessed you with abundant fruit, brought you closer to him, and gave you strength to grow



in holiness over the last several weeks. Perhaps that was not the case. Maybe you struggled to pray, constantly found yourself doing the things you gave up, or perhaps even fell into sin more and more as Lent dragged on. We've been in the desert, and sometimes it feels like it.

As we begin Holy Week, I just want to give you a piece of encouragement. It doesn't matter how good or bad your Lent has been, the Lord still is there, waiting to pour out his abundant grace on you. This last week of Lent is an opportunity to be drawn even more deeply into the Passion of Christ, so we can share more fully in the joy of His Resurrection. 


